- To maintain an active, rotating governing body that represents the diverse elements of the community and which assumes and fulfills the responsibility of managing the agency's affairs within its by-laws.
- To inform the club of developments likely to affect the agency's ability to fulfill this agreement.
- To have a representative attend the Kiwanis weekly meeting in September at which checks will be presented and to speak briefly to the club regarding how the grant monies will be used and how they help to support the grant's purpose within the community.
- To support the fundraising efforts of the Kiwanis Club of High Point through either regular participation and engagement of club activities or by providing volunteers for our annual Chicken Feed (Nov) and Pancake Day (March) fundraisers.
